Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS) is participating in two new programs to ease the admission process for the Class of 2025.

Milwaukee Direct Admit

M-Cubed is a collaboration among Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS), the University of Wisconsin Milwaukee (UWM) and Milwaukee Area Technical College (MATC). One of its goals is to help students seamlessly transition from high school to higher education.

UWM and MATC have worked with MPS on a simplified application process that allows MPS students to automatically be considered for admission to UWM and MATC without having to complete an application. In order for MPS students to be considered for this automatic admission initiative, the student must complete the form and their parent or legal guardian must sign it (if the student is under 18 years of age). The signed form permits MPS and UWM and MATC to share certain education-related information.

Direct Admit Wisconsin

Direct Admit Wisconsin is designed to provide a place for all Wisconsin high school students to access a world-class public education by proactively offering them admission to the Universities of Wisconsin. Following a review of your student's 11th grade transcript (grade point average, math coursework, progression towards graduation), you and your student will receive correspondence in July indicating which UWs are providing them direct admission, and the next steps needed in order to learn more about enrolling within the Universities of Wisconsin. Participating in this program does not commit your student to attend the Universities of Wisconsin.

There are 10 UWs participating in Direct Admit Wisconsin for Fall 2025. They are UW-Green Bay, UW-Milwaukee, UW-Oshkosh, UW-Parkside, UW-Platteville, UW-River Falls, UW-Stevens Point, UW-Stout, UW-Superior and UW-Whitewater. During this process, Universities of Wisconsin system, UWM and/or MATC may request any additional information from the parent/guardian as needed to make an initial decision and/or otherwise facilitate your student’s application/admission.
